The syllabus comprises four units:
Unit A: Managing health and safety

Unit C: Workplace and work equipment safety
Unit DNI: Application of health and safety management in the workplace

Units A, B and C are each assessed by a written examination.

Unit DNI is a workplace-based assignment, requiring learners to conduct a beneficial review of health and safety arrangements in their own organisation.
