## How is it assessed?

The assessments focus on the application of knowledge to help you prepare for health and safety tasks you may face in the workplace:

<b>D11</b> – Know - workplace health and safety principles	Assignment – workplace-based tasks together with simulations, reflective activities and a research topic
<b>D12</b> – Do - controlling workplace health issues	Scenario-based assessment
<b>D13</b> – Do - controlling workplace safety issues	Scenario-based assessment

For each assessment, you will be required to participate in a closing interview about your submitted work.

The qualification requires a minimum of 185 taught hours plus 144 recommended self-study hours and 80 assessment hours.
