Are you already one step closer towards your next NEBOSH Certificate?

Unit IGC1 of this qualification (Management of international health and safety) is common to the International Fire Certificate, the International Construction Certificate and the International General Certificate.

Unit FC2 (Fire Safety Practical Application) is common to the NEBOSH National Certificate in Fire Safety and Risk Management.

You do not have to sit Unit IGC1 or FC2 if you have passed them within the last five years.

How is the course assessed?

Candidates are assessed with a written examination for each of the two taught units and a practical fire risk assessment.

Candidates must carry out a fire risk assessment in a real workplace to demonstrate application of the theory studied.

A qualification parchment is issued on successful completion of the two units and the practical fire risk assessment.

Where can I take a course leading to this qualification?
