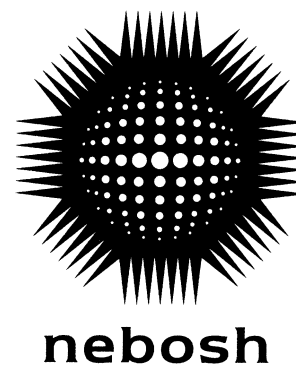

- 10 **Identify** information that could be considered when reviewing an organisation's health and safety performance. (8)
