### **Welcome to the NEBOSH Assessment Platform**

This guidance document will provide you with all the information required to access the new NEBOSH Assessment Platform and complete your assessment on the date specified in your assessment email.

### **Preparing for your Assessment**

Before the day of your assessment, it is important that you are prepared and have all the required technology to complete the assessment. Please ensure you have reviewed the checklist below and are satisfied that you have completed all sections **before** the assessment date and time.

Step	Checklist	
1	I have read the assessment email sent to me by NEBOSH (sent from noreply@nebosh.org.uk) about preparing for the assessment.  This will contain your assessment details and supporting information, including a link to the NEBOSH website where you can access everything you need take the assessment.	
2	I have completed the <u>System Readiness Check</u> on the device and, in the location I will be on the day of the assessment, and, my laptop/desktop meets the minimum technical requirements, including a camera and microphone.	
3	I have run the <u>Talview Speed Test</u> and have made a note of the Download, Upload, Ping and Jitter numbers, so I can provide them in the feedback survey.	
4	I have downloaded the <u>Talview Secure Browser.</u> This is the browser that you will need to take the assessment in.	
5	I have taken the <u>Talview Practice Test</u> and understand what is required during the onboarding process. This provides you an opportunity to go through the Proctoring onboarding experience ahead of the assessment.	
6	I have watched the <u>Proctoring Onboarding video</u> to support my onboarding process.  This allows you to see the onboarding process ahead of the assessment day.	
7	I have read the Technical Learner Guidance document (this document), and I know what to expect during the assessment.  This provides all relevant information required to prepare for taking your assessment.	
8	I know what to do if I need <u>Support before my assessment.</u> This support functionality can be accessed prior to the assessment, during the onboarding process and while in the assessment.	
9	I have my government issued ID ready.	
10	I have watched the <u>Assessment Rules Video</u> , and I understand the assessment rules.  This is an additional resource which outlines the rules of the assessment.	
11	I am taking my assessment in a quiet and private room.

### Using a work/company laptop

We recommend taking your assessment on your personal computer or laptop as work/company devices may have firewalls which make it difficult to access the online assessment platform or download the Talview Secure Browser.

If you do need to use your work/company device, please ensure you provide your IT department with the following specification to allow you to access the required software to take your assessment.

#### **Technical Checks**

Before the assessment day, you will need to ensure you have the appropriate access and that your equipment meets the technical specifications to take your assessment and reduce any assessment day issues.

You can also prepare for your assessment in advance, by using the pre assessment tools below.

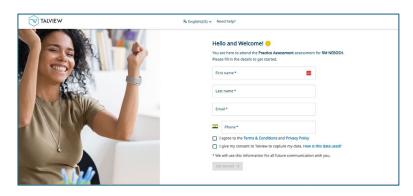
The system readiness check should be taken using the equipment and in the same location in which you will be taking the assessment. This should be in a quiet and private room.

The Talview speed test must be completed to ensure that your device has the appropriate internet access to complete your assessment. If you are experiencing issues with the output, you may need to consider using an alternative internet connection or changing the location where you will be taking the assessment.

The Talview Practice Test provides you with an opportunity to run through the onboarding process. This will prepare you for the day of assessment and should be taken using the equipment in the same location in which you will be taking the assessment.

You must download the Talview Secure Browser before you can access the link.

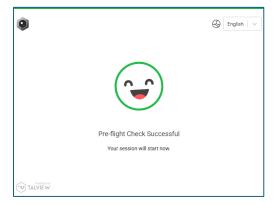
Once you have selected the link, the following screen will appear



Once you have entered your details and have agreed to the check boxes, you will enter the proctored onboarding session.

The demo will take you step by step through the onboarding process in a locked down environment, as you will experience on the day of your assessment.

Once you reach the screen below, you can exit the demo.



You will also receive an email, which will provide an access link to the demo, should you wish to take it again.

### **Downloading the Talview Secure Browser**

To sit the on-screen multiple format assessment, you must download the Talview Secure Browser. This will enable the proctoring services required to sit the assessment.

It is recommended you do this before the day of your assessment so you can access your assessment easily on the day. Once

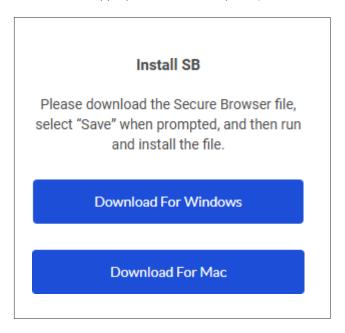
you have downloaded the secure browser you will not be required to do this again.

Please note: If this is not downloaded, you will not be able to access your assessment.

#### **Downloading the Talview Secure Browser on Windows**

1 Select the appropriate download option (**Download for Windows**)

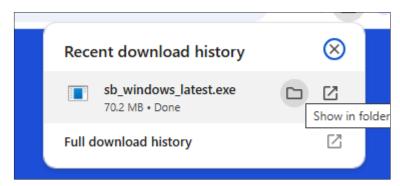


The Talview Secure Browser will start to download.

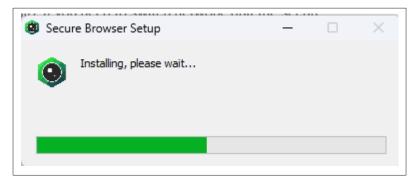

2 Go to the downloads icon and select the **sb\_windows\_latest.exe** link to install.



3 The Talview Secure Browser pop-up will indicate that it is being installed.



4 Once the Talview Secure Browser screen opens with the message Installation complete, you can close the screen.

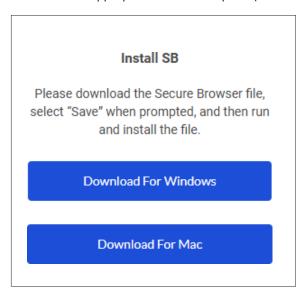
When you have completed the download, you will be ready to access the on-screen assessment on the date and time of the assessment by selecting the **unique assessment link** contained in your email.

**Downloading the Talview Secure Browser on iOS** 

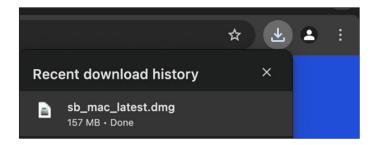
To download the Talview Secure Browser, click here.

1 Select the appropriate download option (Download for Mac)



The Talview Secure Browser will start to download.

2 Go to the downloads icon and select the **Talview Secure Browser** link to install.



The Talview Secure Browser screen will indicate that it is being installed.

Once installed, select the downloaded tile.

3 Once the icons appear below, select the Secure Browser icon and drag it to the Applications folder.

This will move the Secure Browser into your Launch Pad.

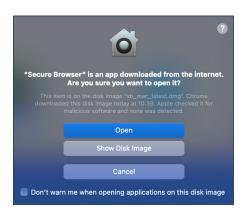


4 You should also see the Secure Browser in the *Downloads* and *Locations* screens.



Launching the Secure Browser prior to the assessment day will ensure it is downloaded correctly and should reduce access issues on the day.

5 In the Launch Pad double click the Secure Browser icon. The image below will appear.



If there are any specific settings enabled on your device which prevent the Secure Browser from opening, you will be prompted to make those adjustments prior to opening the Secure Browser.

Once adjusted and you have selected the Secure Browser, it will open. You can then close it.

When you have completed the download, you will be ready to access the on-screen assessment on the date and time of the assessment by selecting the **unique assessment link** contained in your email.

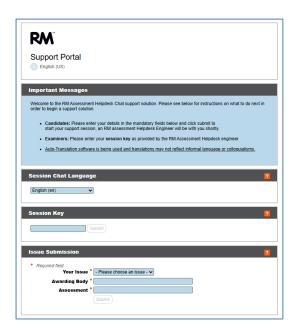
#### **During the assessment**



Once you have downloaded the Secure Browser and accessed the assessment, there will be a chat icon. This will be available at any point within the assessment to help with technical queries. For anything else, please contact NEBOSH directly at info@nebosh.org.uk.

#### How to use the support tool

When you click on the link above or the chat icon within the assessment, you will be taken to the support portal, which will open as a new window in the Secure Browser.



- 1 Ignore the 'Session Key' field and select 'Your issue' from the drop-down menu.
- 2 In the 'Awarding Body' field, enter NEBOSH.
- 3 The 'Assessment' will be provided to you on your Assessment email.
- 4 Enter your assessment name and select **Submit**.

You will be taken to the support screen.

5 Enter your name.

### Taking the assessment

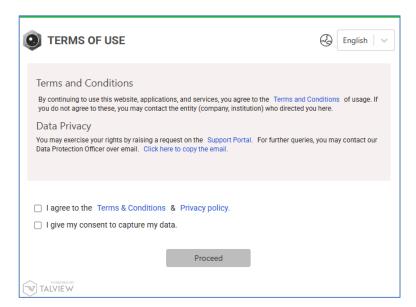
On the day and time of your assessment you will be able to access the assessment by clicking on your **unique assessment link**. This will be available for 24 hours.

**Please note:** It is essential that you disconnect any additional monitors or devices (except for a webcam if you are using one, or a keyboard and mouse - if applicable).

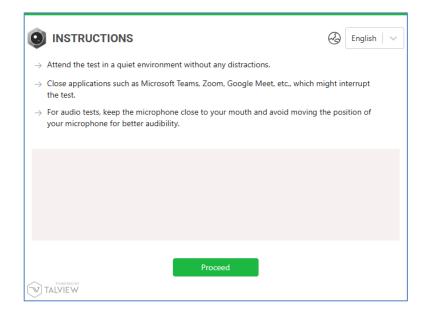
### **Proctoring Onboarding Video**

Once you have completed all aspects of the **check list** and you click on your **unique assessment link**, you will be taken to the onboarding screens, there is a video of the **Proctoring Onboarding video** 

1 You must complete the TERMS OF USE to continue. Tick both boxes and select Proceed.

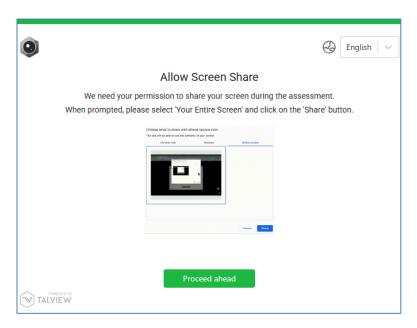


2 Read the instructions and select **Proceed**.

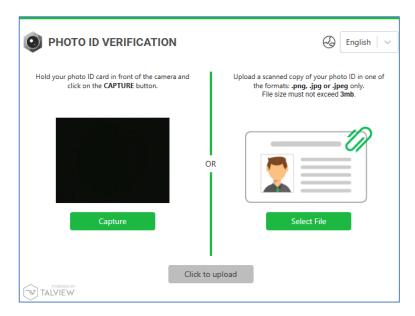
3 To allow screen share, select **Proceed ahead**.



#### 4 Photo verification

Using the **camera (laptop or desktop/webcam)**, take a picture of your approved identification. Please wait until your ID is checked.

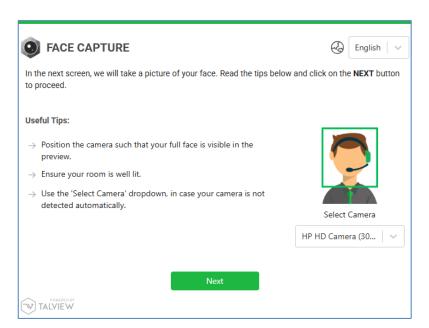
There is also an option to upload an image. The file size limit is 1MB. We do not recommend using external sites to resize the ID to meet the size requirements.



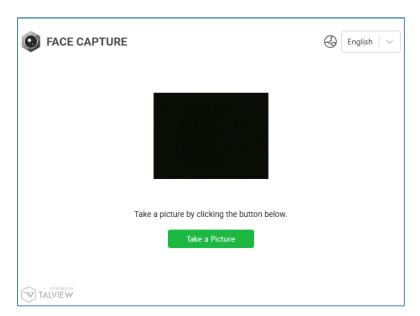

Follow instructions and select Next.



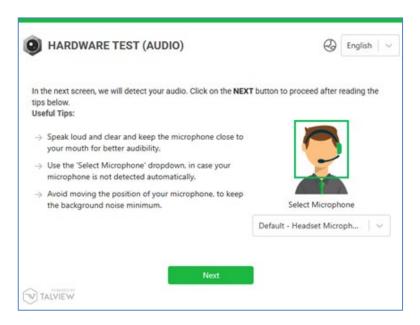
Following the instructions above, when you are ready select **Take a Picture**.



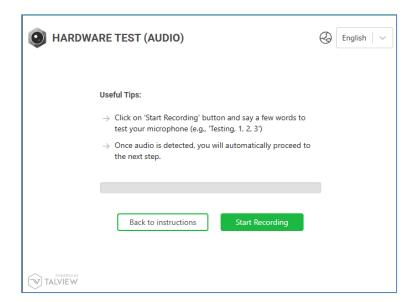

Follow instructions and select Next.



Select **Start Recording** and speak the text shown on screen. As soon as your microphone is detected you will be taken to the next screen.

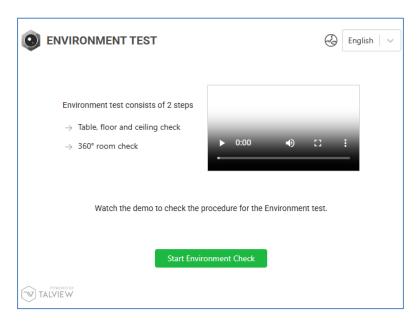

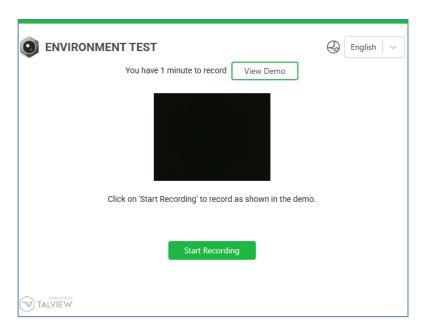
#### 7 Environment test

This is a full room scan of the test environment which includes the table, floor, ceiling and 360° room check using the **primary camera**. Follow the instructions and select **Start Environment Check**. You will need to ensure that the camera is facing outwards.

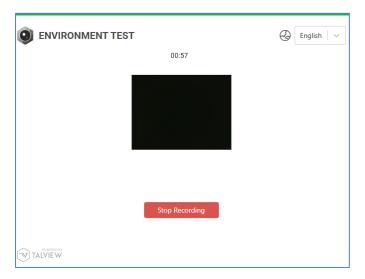


8 When you are ready, select **Start Recording** and complete the environment test.

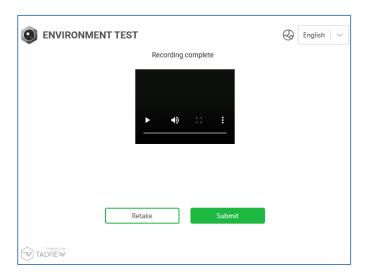

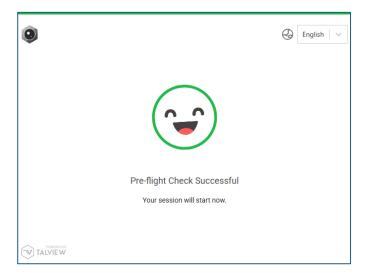
9 Once completed, select Stop Recording.

11 You have now completed the onboarding process and will be taken to the assessment.

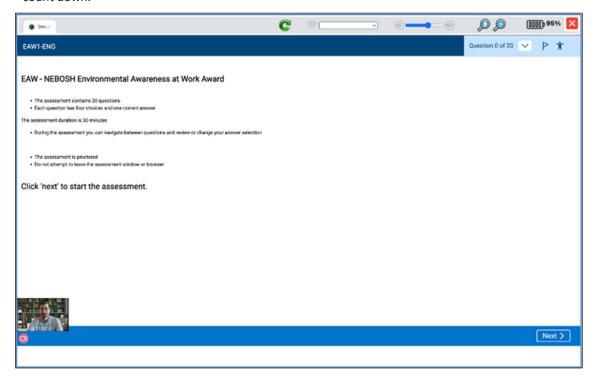

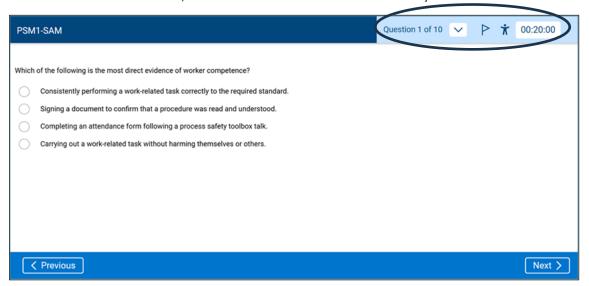
#### **Assessment screen**

Once you have completed the onboarding process, the assessment will open on screen and you will be taken to the introduction page. Please read the information carefully.

Once you are ready to start the test **select Next**. This will start the assessment and the time available will start to count down.

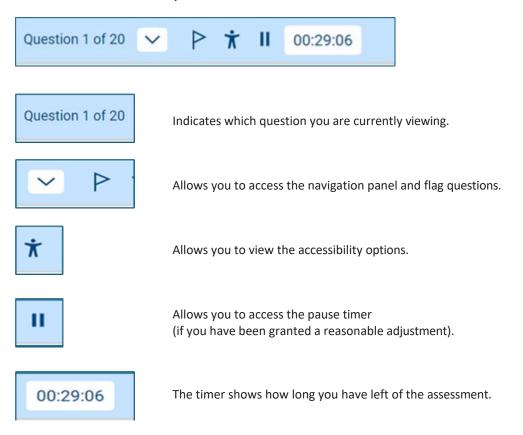


Once in the assessment screen, there are a number of features available to you.

### **Navigation explained**

#### **Previous and next function**

During the assessment you can navigate forwards and backwards to previously accessed questions by selecting the **Previous** and **Next** buttons at the bottom left and right of the assessment screen.

#### **Navigation**

Within navigation you can see the status of the question you have viewed, attempted or flagged. Once you have accessed a question and moved forward within the assessment, you will be able to navigate between questions you have viewed by either selecting **Previous** in the screen, or by **selecting the question number within the navigation panel**.

You can also flag questions for further review by selecting the flag symbol when in the item.

#### Using the navigation panel

You will be able to use the navigation panel to select questions you have previously viewed. This will also show you the status of each question.

Please note: You are not permitted to select questions if you have not previously viewed them.



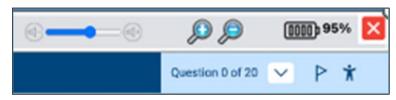
As you navigate through the assessment, the navigation icons will change according to your progress or actions.



- 1 Shows question not viewed.
- Shows question you are viewing.
- 1 Shows question viewed but not answered.
- 2 Shows question viewed and answered.
- 3 Shows question viewed but not answered and flagged for review.
- Shows question viewed and answered and flagged for review.
- 3 Shows question you are viewing which is flagged for review.

#### Zoom in and out

There is an alternative option to increase or decrease the screen size during the assessment without using the accessibility tool. At the top of the screen select the + or – option.

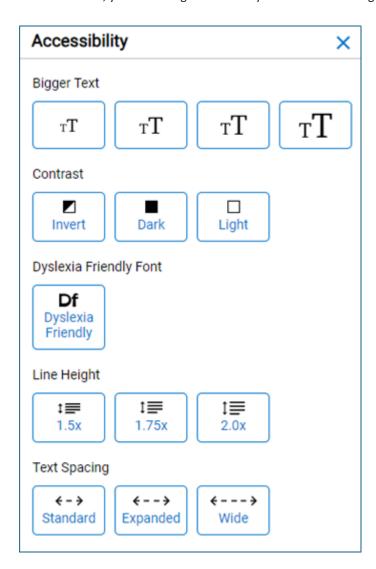

#### **Accessibility**

Select the Accessibility icon and adjust your settings as you require.

Once selected, you can change them at any time and the setting will carry over to the next pages.

### Finishing the assessment

Once you have completed all the questions, you will have the opportunity to go back and review your answers before you submit.

Simply select the Back button and navigate through items by either selecting Previous or using the navigation panel.



If you are happy to proceed and submit your answers, select Logoff.

Please note: Once you have selected Logoff you will not be able to access the assessment again.

You will then see a loading image. This will continue to show on your screen until all the assessment data (including proctoring data) is saved.



**Please note:** Please ensure you wait for the loading screen to stop and clear before leaving the assessment screen. This is to ensure your responses have been uploaded. This can take up to approximately 45 seconds.

Once the loading screen finishes, you can exit the assessment.

#### If you run out of time during the assessment

If you run out of time and do not complete the **Logoff** process as shown above, your answers will still be recorded and your mark will be issued within the relevant timeline for your assessment.

Please do not refer to this document once your assessment has started as this may trigger a finding of potential malpractice through the proctoring system.
