## What kind of people take the NEBOSH National General Certificate?

Many people take the NEBOSH National General Certificate because it gives them the skills and know-how to fulfil their health and safety responsibilities. For others, it's a first step towards a life-long career in occupational safety and health. Some take the Certificate because it's what their employer expects, while others simply want to learn something new and interesting that's useful vocationally.

## What will I gain from this qualification?

**Knowledge** – Whether health and safety is your main responsibility, or just a part of what you do, the NEBOSH National General Certificate will give you vital knowledge to help you perform better in your role at work.

**Enjoyment** – You'll enjoy taking the NEBOSH National General Certificate. You'll discover skills and techniques that are useful and practical, not just theoretical.

**Recognition** – Holders of the NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety are entitled to Associate Membership (AIOSH) of the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH). The qualification also meets the academic requirements for Technical Membership (Tech IOSH) of IOSH and Associate Membership (AIIRSM) of the International Institute of Risk and Safety Management (IIRSM).

**Career development** – For some, the NEBOSH National General Certificate is a first step towards a career as a health and safety professional. For others, it forms part of an important set of qualifications that will bring them success and advancement in whatever field they choose.

## What will my employer gain from this qualification?

**A safer workplace** – Health and safety is important. It protects people from injury and loss of life. People with the NEBOSH National General Certificate know how to help their employer avoid prosecution, litigation, absence costs and loss of reputation.

## What does the course cover?

## How is the course assessed?

Candidates are assessed with written examinations for each of the two taught units. There is also a practical assessment to help you apply your learning at work and add value for your employer.

## Are you already one step towards your next NEBOSH Certificate?

Management of health and safety unit (NGC1) is common to the following qualifications:

- NEBOSH National General Certificate
- NEBOSH National Construction Certificate
- NEBOSH National Fire Certificate

If you study another qualification listed within 5 years of passing this unit, you will not need to re-sit it.

Once you have achieved the NEBOSH General Certificate, you are only one unit away from achieving the NEBOSH International General Certificate too. Controlling Workplace Hazards (GC2) and the Practical Application (GC3) units are now common to both qualifications so you would only need to pass the Management of International Health and Safety Unit (IGC1) to secure the NEBOSH International General Certificate.

## Where can I take a course leading to the NEBOSH Certificate?

Details of training providers that represent NEBOSH throughout the world are on our website. These training providers offer courses to fit around your requirements:

- Distance or E-learning
- Day or evening courses
- Block release or modular courses

Sometimes courses can be arranged to take place where you work. Employers can also become accredited NEBOSH course providers so that they can provide in-house training for staff.
