Purpose	The Product Developer is responsible for the development of new products (including courses and qualifications) and the review and maintenance of existing products. The role also requires input to the achievement and maintenance of accreditation with the regulatory authorities and professional bodies, where appropriate.

Responsibilities Activities/tasks 	 Ensuring products are fit for purpose and achieve excellence in design by; Contributing to the design, creation, development, launch and maintenance of specific products and systems in accordance with project plans. Manage allocated projects. Attend relevant Product Development Panels (and similar) with stakeholders. Liaise with contractors/consultants/writers as necessary for product development according to project plans. Producing technical content for syllabus guides. Contributing to assessment design and development. Producing course materials/content (as necessary). Assisting in the delivery of product launch/assessment training modules for Learning Partners (e.g. product awareness webinars delivered by other members of the department). Credit/levelling/accreditation with regulatory authorities and professional bodies (as appropriate). Work with Learning Partners and Relationship Management to ensure content of guide portfolio evolves to best serve the needs of customers Ensuring products remain fit for purpose and achieve excellence in design by; Contributing to product lifecycle analysis and review. Completing textual/formatting revisions and syllabus changes. Updating legislation and other standards which refer directly to one or more NEBOSH qualification syllabuses. General administration. Liaise with contractors/consultants/writers as necessary for product maintenance according to project plans.

The role supports the Learning and Assessment Directorate in the production of products. The role supports other Departments to make better decisions by providing them with advice, information and/or reports.
